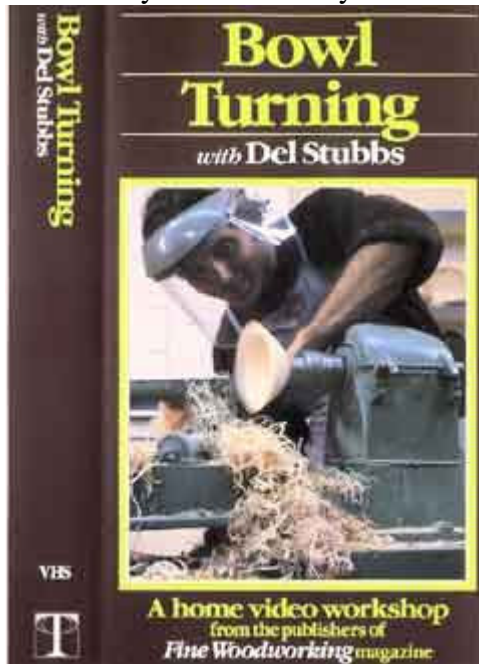


Bowl Turning with Del Stubbs, 120 minutes

In this video (VHS, also available on DVD from the usual suppliers) Del Stubbs discusses and demonstrates lathe modifications, tool shapes and tool sharpening, different tools, different cuts, techniques for dealing with thin wall, natural edge and end grain bowls and adds some design tips for bowl turners. In the course of which he provides a remarkable number of useful ideas.

This is a high quality instructional video with excellent close-ups, clear explanations and an astonishing amount of useful information.

This video was made in 1985 and apparently Del Stubbs was way ahead of his time as it remains fresh and relevant over 20 years later.

Del Stubbs was a vigorous professional turner, innovative and unabashedly enthusiastic about turning. His teaching style is exemplary and his enthusiasm infectious as he demonstrates lathe modifications, the use of a variety of tools (including his first home made gouge!) and produces a variety of bowls. Along the way he drops more useful hints per hour than any other video I've seen to date.
